



Identity in Christ

Learning what it means to find our identity in Christ alone

Day 1: Loved

Scripture Reading: John 3:16, Ephesians 2:4-5, 1 John 4:19

Reflection:

- Consider that other religions make man do good works in hopes of earning favor. God loved us first, giving His only Son's life.
- Do you ever struggle with God's love? Choose today to believe the truth.

Prayer: Lord, thank you that you are love and did not require perfection from me to receive your love which bring eternal life.

Day 2: Forgiven

Scripture Reading: 1 John 1:9-10, Hebrews 4:16, Isaiah 43:25

Reflection:

- Do we believe we can boldly enter the presence of God as a forgiven person? Christ has given us access to the Creator of the world!
- Who do we believe more? God who forgives us or Satan who condemns?

Prayer: Without the sacrifice of Christ we would have to find a way to pay for our own sin. Thank you that Jesus did all that was necessary.

Day 3: Called

Scripture Reading: Romans 8:28, 1 Peter 2:9, Ephesians 2:13

Reflection:

- God's calling relates to His desire for us as well as His future plans.
- What has God put in your heart to do for Him?

Prayer: Father, I am grateful You desired relationship with me and you want to use me in a unique way to reach others.

Day 4: Redeemed

Scripture Reading: Colossians 1:13-14, Ephesians 1:7, Romans 3:24

Reflection:

- Redemption means God bought us out of slavery to sin, to set us free to love and serve Him willingly.
- Meditate on the freedom we have which means we serve him out of love, gratitude, and thankfulness rather than fear, obligation, or duty.

Prayer: Father I commit to serve you as a son or daughter, not a slave

Day 5: Adopted

Scripture Reading: Romans 8:14-16, John 1:12, Ephesians 2:19

Reflection:

- Our Earthly parents often fail us in big and small ways. Consider a perfect God as a Father who wants only good things from His Children and leaves them an inheritance of good gifts.

Prayer: Thank you for your love as a Father and active work for our good.

Day 6: Righteous

Scripture Reading: Romans 5:1, 2 Cor 5:17-21, Philippians 3:9

Reflection:

- Righteousness comes as a gift from God at salvation, not of our own effort.
- Reflect on the peace which comes from Jesus doing everything required. Breathe deep as you realize no amount of striving or performance can improve your standing with Christ.

Prayer: Even though I still sin, I choose to believe you see me at righteous because of my faith, not my works which fall short. Help me to walk in this truth and not accept the lies of the Enemy.

Day 7: Our Response

Scripture Reading: Galatians 3:27, Ephesians 1:4, 2 Peter 1:3

Reflection:

- Picture yourself "wearing" Christ and his holiness. As we walk with him, we engage in the process of becoming more Christ-like.
- Through his indwelling presence, God promises to give us everything we need for life and godliness.

Prayer: Thank you for saving me and giving me all I need to live the Christian life. I trust you to help me grow and will obey as your give wise advice.

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
