



Becoming a Christian Leader

Attributes needed to be a Christian leader

Day 1: Build Your Character

Scripture Reading: Matthew 7:24, Romans 5:4, Philippians 1:11

Reflection:

- Character is essential to being a leader and person of faith. How have you allowed God to build your character?
- Think about areas you need to avoid so you can grow and have Godly character.

Prayer: Ask God to build and maintain your character. Pray He guides you down righteous paths and shows you the areas in your life that need work.

Day 2: Become a Person of Influence

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 4:11-16, 2 Timothy 2:2

Reflection:

- God calls Christians to influence both fellow Christians and unbelievers.
- To become a person of influence then chose to live out your faith on a daily basis. When you live a Godly life then others will begin to follow your example.

Prayer: Ask God to lead your life so you can influence others.

Day 3: Prepare through Personal Development

Scripture Reading: 1 Thessalonians 5:11, John 15: 2, Ephesians 4:15

Reflection:

- Becoming a mature Christian and leader requires intentional growth.
- How are you growing your faith and leadership?

Prayer: Pray God would reveal the areas you need to develop in, both personally and spiritually.

Day 4: Have Vision

Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 29:11, Proverbs 29:18, Acts 26:19

Reflection:

- A God given vision is needed to live an effective and fulfilled life
- Vision is a desired outcome of the things you want to do and accomplish in the future.
- Take some time thinking about what God wants you to do in the next 3-5 years. Allow God to give you a vision for the future

Prayer: Ask God to give you a clear perspective of your vision.

Day 5: Maintain a Positive Attitude

Scripture Reading: Philippians 2:5, Ephesians 4:23, Hebrews 13:15-16

Reflection:

- How is your attitude? Does it reflect a Godly life?
- Becoming a leader requires having and maintaining a positive attitude. This can be a daily challenge.
- How can you use your story to glorify God?

Prayer: Ask God to help you maintain a positive attitude. Ask Him to show you where your attitude isn't lining up with scripture.

Day 6: Choose to Serve

Scripture Reading: John 13: 3-17, Ephesians 6:5

Reflection:

- Serving others requires humility and being deliberate about focusing on others.
- In what ways are you serving the people around you (Your boss, teachers, pastors, peers, parents)?
- Think about who you can serve today and then serve them.

Prayer: Pray for humility. Ask God to show you practical ways you can serve others.

Day 7: Find and Focus on Personal Talents

Scripture Reading: Matthew 25: 14-30, Romans 12:6

Reflection:

- God gives each person a set of unique talents. Have you found your personal talents? Start the process of knowing and clarifying your talents.
- Ask a trusted friend or pastor to help you find your talents.
- Once you have found your talents start to use them for a Godly purpose.

Prayer: Pray God would show you the talents you have. Ask God for wisdom on how to start using them.
