

BLANKET NAME GAME

SUPPLIES

- 2 Chairs (to stand on)
- Large Blanket or Sheet

IGNITE GAME

Blanket Name Game is an effective and fun way to help students in your group learn each others' names.

INSTRUCTIONS

SET-UP

- Have students go around and say their first name - usually best to do this 2 times
- Tell students to pay attention and remember people's names
- Divide students into 2 groups
- Choose 2 people who will stand on the chairs and hold the blanket or sheet between them - creating a wall between the groups
- Have the groups stand on each side of the blanket

GAME PLAY

- At the start of the game, each team will quietly choose one member to go stand facing the blanket
- When each team has a member standing facing the blanket, the two people holding the blanket will drop it
- The students facing each other need to say the name of the person they are facing
- The first student to say the other's name wins
- The student who lost joins the winning team
- The game continues until all students are on one team, or time runs out.

This is a fast-paced, high energy, and fun way to help students learn and remember each other's names.
